

ISOPREP Completion Instructions:

1. Purpose: Personnel Recovery preparation is required to prepare for a situation when a traveler needs to be authenticated after they have become isolated, captured, missing, or detained; whether through accident (e.g., vehicle breaks down en route to a location), political turmoil (e.g., riot) or criminal/terrorist action (e.g., kidnapping). Travelers should be prepared to survive unassisted for no less than 96 hours.
2. DOD and DOD sponsored travelers will have a Digital Isolated Personnel Report (ISOPREP) submitted prior to entry into the AOR *More restrictive requirements may be mandated by COCOM
3. ISOPREPS should be filed electronically on the Personnel Recovery Mission Software (PRMS).
4. The PRMS software requires two (2) digital pictures smaller than 200k as well as fingerprints.
*Check the specific theater entry requirements below for exceptions to this policy.

***Specific Requirements and Exceptions:**

SOUTHCOM:

- Personnel are required to digitally submit their ISOPREP within six (6) months of entering SOUTHCOM AOR or, if already completed, they must review/update their ISOPREP every six (6) months.
- Fingerprints are not required by SOUTHCOM.

AFRICOM:

- ISOPREP must be completed or reviewed within twelve (12) months of entering the AFRICOM AOR.
- Photos and Fingerprints are not required by AFRICOM or the PRMS SIPR website for completion

EUCOM:

- ISOPREP must be completed or reviewed within twelve (12) months of entry into the USEUCOM AOR.
- Fingerprints are not required on the ISOPREP form to enter the USEUCOM AOR

PACOM: ISOPREP must be completed and reviewed within twelve months of entry into the PACOM AOR.

CENTCOM: Follow service requirements.

NORTHCOM: No requirements.
