

**Personnel Recovery - Survival, Evasion, Resistance, and Escape (SERE):**

1. All personnel traveling in the USEUCOM area of responsibility (AOR) must complete fundamental (or higher) or continuation Survival, Evasion, Resistance, and Escape (SERE) Level A training (per the JPRA, Joint SERE Training Standards, 5 November 2010).
  - a. Training must be completed within 36 months prior to entering the USEUCOM AOR.
2. SERE 100.1 computer-based training satisfies the Level A requirement and as continuation training. This unclassified training can be found on the Joint Knowledge Online (JKO) page <http://jko.jten.mil/>.
  - a. Under "Course Catalog" tab, search for course number "J3TA-US022".
  - b. This 36 month training requirement applies regardless of previous code of conduct training.
  - c. In addition, travelers must complete all Services related training and requirements.
3. For non-CAC users, go to <https://jkodirect.jten.mil/>, read/accept the DoD Warning Banner, select the appropriate "First Time Student, no CAC" option and follow the instructions. Upon acquiring a non-CAC JKO account, under "Course Catalog" tab, search for course number "J3TA-US022".
